

Role and responsibilities of the Chief Information Security Officer, NHA

1. NHA Information Security Organisation (NHA ISO) shall be headed by Chief Information Security Officer (CISO) of NHA.
2. The responsibilities of Information Security Officer (NHA-ISO) are to ensure that:
 - (a) The key infrastructure and application service staff are uniquely identified, and their responsibilities are clearly defined to ensure that at each stage of the evolution, the organization remains focused on meeting the needs of the customer and user, and the services are provided in a secure manner.
 - (b) The health of all the systems is continuously monitored to prevent occurrence of any security incidents.
 - (c) Cyber Security drills are conducted at defined frequency.
 - (d) Security audits are conducted periodically, and compliance is monitored till closure.
 - (e) CISO shall take appropriate measures to ensure smooth functioning of the IT systems, protect information and IT systems and to maintain continuity of business functions, duly putting in place the controls defined in this Policy.
 - (f) Update information security policy based on new business functions and its compliance, legal or regulatory requirements
 - (g) Allocation of information security roles, responsibilities, and authorities in accordance with NISP
 - (h) Making efforts for the certification of the NHA Information Systems for compliance with the International and National standards for Information Security.
